Enquiry

You have received a Prospectus and Registration Form from the School. Completion of the Form and payment of the Registration Fee indicates your interest in a place at Stowe. We will then invite you to attend our Year 6 Taster Day.

2

Private Visit & Interview

Between September 2021 and June 2022 you should book a Private Visit at Stowe. On this visit your child will be interviewed. Your son or daughter will also need to sit the ISEB Pre-Tests or UKiset in October or November 2022.

3

Offer of Place

Following the Private Visit and Interview, the receipt of the ISEB Pre-Tests or UKiset results and a reference from your child's current school, a decision will be made about whether to offer your child a place at Stowe. Conditional offers are made in January 2023.

4

Acceptance of Place

On receipt of the completed Acceptance of Place Form and payment of the Acceptance Deposit, your child's place at Stowe is reserved, subject to meeting the entry requirements.

5

Entrance Tests

The final requirement is for your child to sit our own Entrance Tests in January of the year of entry.
