- 1. A detailed programme will be available on the day.
- 2. Seating in the marquee will be by House.
- 3. Picnic lunch
  - <u>Please provide a picnic</u> for your family and leave it on or under one of the designated House tables on the South Front during speeches and prize-giving. We strongly advise the use of a coolbox, especially in the case of hot weather.
  - Picnic tables and chairs will be provided for everyone. For reasons of economy, picnic chairs need to be carried from the marquee after the speeches and prize-giving to use at the picnic tables.
  - Seating for the Picnic will be by House, except for the Upper Sixth and their parents who will be seated together. In addition, there will be designated seating for Old Stoics and their families.
  - Picnics can be ordered in advance and collected at the School on Speech Day. To see the picnic menu and to order a picnic, go to Boycott Farm Shop. Please place your order as early as possible and before 19 May. Picnics will be available for collection after the speeches and prize-giving, from the terrace by the South Front steps.
